
UNIST Readmission Application for 2023 Fall(2nd) semester

We are pleased to announce the readmission guidelines for the 2023 Fall(2nd) semester as follows:

- 1. Applicability: Undergraduate students who dropped out or were expelled.
 - A student shall be readmitted <u>after two semesters</u>, which includes the semester during which the withdrawal(drop out) or expulsion occurred.
 - A student who left the school in the form of a withdrawal(drop out) or expulsion wishes to be readmitted to an undergraduate course, the student must submit readmission application within **3 years**.
- 2. Students who are not eligible for readmission.
 - Those who have exceeded the academic period(enrollment duration).
 - Those who were expelled due to disciplinary action.
 - Those expelled after receiving three academic warnings (applicable to the students admitted from the 2014 academic year).
- 3. Readmission Application Period
 - Students submission period : ~ June 30th(Fri), 2023.
 - * Before the relevant Committee schedule for each semester.
 - * Submit to the affiliated Academic & Student Affairs Team of the College
- 4. Application Procedure: Submit the application to the Academic and Student Affairs Team of the affiliated College with academic advisor's opinion and an approval of department(school) head
- 5. Required Documents for Readmission <refer to the attachment>
 - 1 copy of the "Request for readmission" (including the study plan and opinion of academic advisor on readmission)
 - 1 copy of the "Notice of collection and use of personal information"
 - 1 copy of the academic transcript.
- 6. Readmission Procedure



7. Important Notes

- Those expelled with academic warnings shall be expelled permanently upon receiving another academic warning after readmission.

- Readmission is only permitted once.
- Those who do not enroll after readmission are not allowed to apply again.
- Readmitted students shall not be allowed to take a leave of absence for the first semester after readmittance except for the reasons of illness, pregnancy and childbirth and military service.
- Readmitted students should pay the readmission fee in addition to the regular tuition fee.
